First, thank you for your assistance in publishing some information about the 1929 Chrysler roadster that I am selling. It was valued by appraisal in 2014 at \$55,000. (Appraisal available on request.)

1929 Chrysler Roadster: It is completely restored and modified to a very high standard. The paint and bodywork, done in jet black is top quality. Everything fits properly, the body is extremely straight, and the paint quality is extremely high. The chrome plating is all fresh looking and excellent quality. The interior is beautifully done in leather, and the top and top bows are excellent as well. It is clean and nicely detailed throughout, both on top and underneath.

It looks mostly stock on the outside, except for the lowered stance, wider wire wheels, and wider tires, but in reality it has been extensively modified in a very tasteful way to provide the power and improved driving experience that the street rod community desires.

It has a small block Chevrolet engine, dressed up with coated headers, intake manifold and Carter AFB carburetor, and an automatic transmission with a nice aftermarket "Stock-look" shifter. It has Tilt steering column, full instrumenta-

tion, and Kugel independent front suspension and rack and pinion steering, chrome wire wheels and a single rear mounted spare. It is also equipped with a heater.
